



UNIFORM INFORMATION FOR CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR

The following items are the required school uniform guidelines for Downtown Miami Charter School. All students are expected to follow these guidelines.

School uniforms are to be purchased exclusively from All Uniform Wear uniform company.

Please see the DMCS Parent Handbook for the full description of our Uniform Policy.

Students in grades K-6

DMCS royal blue, navy, or gold polo, short or long sleeved

Charter Schools USA khaki or navy blue logo bottoms (shorts, slacks, skorts)

Belt

White socks

Closed toe and heel shoe

DMCS navy blue PE t-shirt (optional for K-6)– can be worn under polo shirt on PE days

DMCS gold Field Trip Shirt (only to be worn on field trip days)

Students are welcome to wear a navy blue sweatshirt or jacket with the DMCS or Charter Schools USA logo embroidered on it to and from school, at recess, or during PE on cold days.

Hair must be combed down, no spikes, with no unnatural colors. Students are not permitted to wear hair hanging in their face, which obstructs the eyes.

No bandanas, hats or headbands are permitted.

Uniform procedures while waiting for order delivery

Please staple a copy of your child's receipt for the uniform order inside the Agenda Book if you are waiting for a delivery from All Uniform Wear. By doing this we will understand that your child's uniform has been ordered and is on the way very shortly. While waiting for the order, students must wear a polo shirt along with appropriate shorts/slacks/skort. No capri pants allowed.

Uniform Violations

Level 1- Warning given to parent and student; will also be issued a Uniform Violation Notice.

Level 2- Student receives a detention

Level 3- After 3 detentions, the student will be suspended.

Parents will be required to bring the proper uniform for a child to be admitted to class when a student does not arrive to school in the proper uniform.

All uniforms are subject to approval from the school administration.
